# National Certificate in Demolition (Introductory Skills) Level Two



This qualification is a great place to start your career in the Demolition industry.

The qualification covers:

- Working safely at roadwork sites
- Using fall arrest systems
- Erecting non-modifiable scaffolding
- Removing asbestos products, under direct supervision
- Health and Safety issues
- Operating a range of hand and portable power tools including pavement breakers, generators, and compressors

## How does the training work?

*On-job*

On-job industry training is using everyday work activities and experience and learning from your supervisor or mentor.

When you enrol you will receive a workbook which will explain what you need to do to complete the qualification. It will also include assessment guides detailing the knowledge and skills required for achieving each unit standard in the qualification.

In order for your training to be effective your employer will need to be able to provide a mentor/coach for you in the workplace. It is the role of this person to coach you through the qualification requirements and verify when you are ready to be assessed.

*Off-job*

Units 6400, 6401 and 6402 require you to attend a two-day first aid course.  
Unit 5627 requires you to attend a Transit approved Traffic Controller course.

## How long will it take?

This qualification is made up of 63 credits. Each credit will generally require 10 hours of learning time, depending on how much experience you have.

## Other Information

Once you have finished this qualification you can continue a career pathway onto the National Certificate in Demolition (Equipment Operator) Level 3 and the National Certificate in Demolition (Site Supervisor) Level 4.

## Cost

### Enrolment Fee \$60

This is a one-off fee and provides a life-time entry to InfraTrain New Zealand Limited.

### Monthly Subscription Fee \$50

The monthly subscription fee is payable for a minimum of 12 months. If you complete before the 12 month period is up, you will be charged the remainder of the 12 months.

These fees do not include the cost of assessment. This is a cost which is determined between yourself and your assessor.
