

# National Certificate in Demolition (Site Supervisor) Level Four

This qualification recognises the skills and knowledge required to work as a demolition site supervisor. The qualification covers:

- Investigate, plan and supervise demolition work
- Knowledge of legislative requirements
- Understanding of principles and methods associated with confined spaces
- Hazard identification
- Control of plant and machinery
- Preparation of a site safety plan

## How does the training work?

*On-job*

On-job industry training is using everyday work activities and experience and learning from your supervisor or mentor.

When you enrol you will receive a workbook which will explain what you need to do to complete the qualification. It will also include assessment guides detailing the knowledge and skills required for achieving each unit standard in the qualification.

In order for your training to be effective your employer will need to be able to provide a mentor/coach for you in the workplace. It is the role of this person to coach you through the qualification requirements and verify when you are ready to be assessed.

*Off-job*

Units 6400, 6401 and 6402 require you to attend a one-day first aid course.

Unit 5628 requires you to attend a Transit approved Site Traffic Management Supervisor (STMS) course.

## How long will it take?

This qualification is made up of 137 credits. Each credit will generally require 10 hours of learning time, depending on how much experience you have.

## Cost

### **Enrolment Fee \$60**

This is a one-off fee and provides a life-time entry to InfraTrain New Zealand Limited.

### **Monthly Subscription Fee \$35**

The monthly subscription fee is payable for a minimum of 18 months. If you complete before the 18 month period is up, you will be charged the remainder of the 18 months.

These fees do not include the cost of assessment. This is a cost which is determined between yourself and your assessor.

### **Subsidies**
